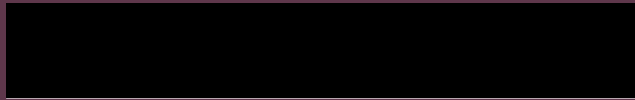


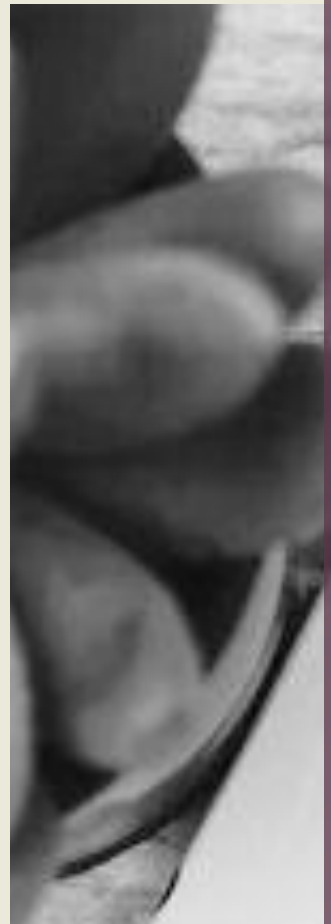

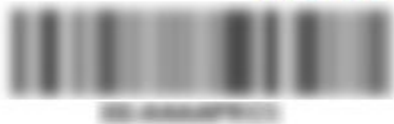

# Etiquette and cultural expectations in nairobi kenya

- Every contact between people in Kenya starts with a greeting.
- shake hands and make polite small talk with the shopkeepers.
- Shaking hands upon meeting and departure is normal between all the men present.
- Women shake hands with each other, but with men only in more sophisticated contexts

## What is considered rude in Kenya?

- The use of the left hand by itself to receive and pass items is considered improper.
- Taking photographs of another person without permission is frowned upon, particularly in rural areas.
- The Kenyan attitude towards time is mostly patient and relaxed.
